Parking Incidents

On Monday this week an incident was reported to the school regarding a near miss between a reversing car and a pedestrian. The incident happened near the entrance barrier to the school car park.

On Tuesday the school minibuses were being used for a school trip. They were unable to leave the school car park due to inconsiderate parking near the car park barrier. **PLEASE DO NOT PARK** on any of the yellow painted areas within the school entrance. This area is a **NO PARKING** area and has heavy pedestrian usage, parents and children, when the school gates are open. Blocking this area also prevents goods deliveries to the school and emergency access for ambulances to the care home next door to the school.
