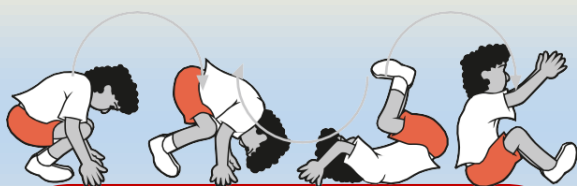
## Thanet Endeavour Learning Trust

Can all children ensure they have their black/blue shorts and Bromstone PE t-shirt underneath their tracksuit this term.

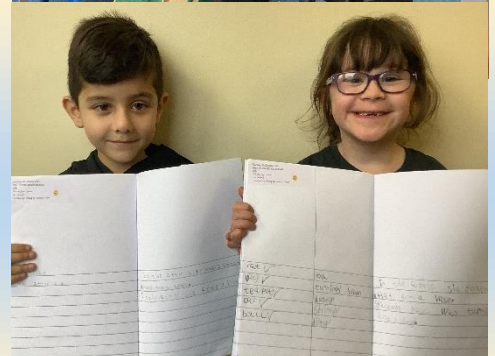
The children will be using gymnastic equipment this term and therefore they must have bare feet, and wearing shorts and t-shirt for health and safety reasons.
